QUARTERLY UTILITY BILL PROCEDURES UPDATE

Effective March 15, 2023, the policy and procedures regarding quarterly utility bill payments and shut-offs have changed. The procedures are as follows:

Utility bills are mailed out quarterly within the first 7-10

days of the months of January, April, July, and October, and are due 30 days from the billing date (not the date received in the mail). If you do not receive your bill by the 15th of the month of the quarter indicated, please contact Town Hall for a duplicate bill. We strongly encourage residents to sign up to receive copies of their bills via email.

Last quarter, we notified you that any accounts more than two (2) quarters past due would be at risk for shut-off. Starting with the 1st Quarter 2023 bill, this time frame will be reduced to one (1) quarter past due. Quarterly bills not paid by the due date are assessed a 5% penalty fee on the full balance owed, and if not paid within two (2) weeks after the due date, water service will be shut off. If shut-off occurs, a \$50 Shut-Off fee will be assessed, and in order for service to be restored, the current account balance and \$50 Turn-On fee must be paid in full.

NEW FORMAT FOR TOWN COMMISSIONERS' MEETINGS TO START IN MAY

Beginning in May, the Town Commissioners' meetings will adopt a new format in efforts to increase productivity. The first meeting of the month, which is held on the 2nd Tuesday, will be a Legislative meeting and the second meeting, held on the 4th Tuesday, will be a Working meeting.

During a Legislative meeting, the Commissioners will make decisions and vote on what was discussed in the previous Working meeting. The Legislative meeting is open to the public, but no comment will be taken, other than at the end of the meeting. The Commissioners will also review and approve the Accounts Payable for the month. The monthly reports for Miller Environmental, the Maintenance department, the Cecil County Sheriff's Office, and the Budget to Actual for the previous month, will be posted on our website prior to the Legislative meeting for public review. When the reports are posted, notifications will be sent via email and posted to our Facebook page.

Public comment is welcome and will be requested for action items prior to voting at the next Legislative meeting.

PET ORDINANCE: CHICKENS

On February 28th, the Commissioners approved the proposal set forth by the Planning and Zoning Commission to amend Ordinance #2009-01. The amendment allows for residents in all residential zones of Charlestown to own chickens, with some exceptions, depending on the zoning classification.

In order to own chickens, you must meet all requirements listed in the Ordinance, such as obtaining a Town permit and providing proof of registration with the State of Maryland. Please note that if you live in a section of Town that has a Homeowners Association (HOA), other restrictions may apply.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- ♦ Please do not cover up your water meters. In case of water emergencies, or during quarterly billing, we need to have quick access to your meter to stop leaks or perform necessary maintenance. Covering the meters with flowerbeds or automobiles makes this process much harder for all of us.
- ◆ Please ensure that your residence has a visible house number from the street. In case of emergencies, you may need to be found quickly. Please call the Charlestown Fire Company at (410) 287-6451 for a house number.
- **Update your contact information with us.** If you are new to Charlestown, or your phone, email or mailing address recently changed, please notify Town Hall as soon as possible. It is important that we have this information so that we can contact you in case of emergencies, and to ensure utility bills are delivered to you efficiently.
- If you have an active Payment Plan with us, payments are due on the 1st of every month to avoid late fees and/or shut-offs.
