- 1. Removed lights from the cemetery fence, town hall roof, and ice house that were part of the Cecil Lights Winter Nights display.
- 2. Thawed out the meter crock due to a damaged water crock, which caused the setter inside to freeze.
- 3. Repaired and straightened the historic sign in front of the church, which had been struck by a vehicle.
- 4. Seeded and mulched an area affected by a water leak in Trinity Woods.
- 5. Replaced the motor on the chemical pump with a DC volt motor at the water tower.
- 6. Set up barricades and posted no parking signs for the Ice Splash event.
- 7. Replaced the gate at Fair Green Park and repaired slats in the playground fencing.
- 8. Salted and plowed roads in preparation for winter weather throughout the month.
- 9. Replaced additional water meters and radios, connecting existing radios where necessary.
- 10. Removed banners that were blown into telephone wires by the storm across town.
- 11. Cleared tree debris from Fireman's Field and Foot Log, which was handled by Cecil Tree Service.
- 12. Conducted weekly trash collection in parks and public spaces for Trash Tech's pickup every Wednesday.
- 13. Performed two brush pickups and collected bulk waste as needed throughout the month.
