Tasker Beach Restoration

The Town of Charlestown, here and after referred to as "Town, will receive sealed bids for the **Tasker Lane Beach restoration project. The bids shall also include diagrams of the work being performed.**

Scope of Work

Specifics for the RFP:

- 170' sill, backfilled with sand and planted with native shoreline vegetation.
- Provisions for a boat ramp on 317 Tasker property--to be paid for by the homeowner.
- Work sites are accessible by land.
- Vendor must provide drawings/diagrams to MDE, Corps of Engineers, DNR and any other applicable governing body for approval and be responsible for all permit applications.
- Vendor must be an Approved marine contractor.

All bids should be sealed and clearly marked "Bid No. Tasker #26-03, Tasker Beach," and be delivered to Ken Hamilton, Town of Charlestown, P.O. Box 154, Charlestown, MD 21914, no later than 2:00 PM p.m., EST, on May14, 2026.

Contractual Requirement's

- Contractor is to include all necessary supplies to complete this project.
 - Contractor shall furnish all equipment and labor necessary to comply with this contract at its expense.
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- Contractor shall hold the Town harmless from any liability and penalties incurred as a result of the negligent conduct or willful misconduct of the Contractor's business in the Town. Contractor shall agree to defend or reimburse the Town for any expenses incurred by the Town as a result thereof in the Town.
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- Contractor shall retain during the life of the contract the Statutory Workmen's Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance for all their employees to be engaged in work on the project under this contract.
 - Contractor shall not begin work until the contractor has first filed with the Town satisfactory evidence that insurance is in full force and effect. All insurance binders shall indicate that said insurance shall not be cancelled or changed within providing the Town with thirty (30) days advance written notice.
 - Contractor shall maintain, during the life of this contract, Bodily Injury, Liability and Property Damage Insurance to protect him while performing work covered by this contract. The amount of such insurance shall not be less than One Million (\$1,000,000)
 - Contractor may provide a single limit policy of Liability Insurance in an amount of not less than Five Million (\$5,000,000)
 - Contractor shall present to the Town evidence of insurance coverage. Insurance certificates shall state that coverage provided shall not be cancelled or modified without thirty (30) days advance written notice to the Town

No announcement of award will be made until the bids have been evaluated by the Town. Notice of Award will be given to the successful bidder in writing.

The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to make an award, if any, that in their opinion, will best suit the needs of the Town.

All bids shall be submitted (typed or written in ink. no change orders unless the scope changes i.e. (act of God), weather is not on the town, and the end date must be met.

The lowest bid that includes everything in the RFP for quote shall be the basis of award.

If the bidder to whom award is made shall fail to execute the contract within 10 business days from notice-of-award, the award may be annulled and the contract awarded to the second lowest responsible bidder and such bidder shall fulfill every stipulation embraced herein as if he were the original party to whom the award was made, or the Town, may reject any or all bids as its interest may require.

Bidders are expected to examine the Invitation to Bid, the Scope of Work, Contractual Requirements and General Information. In case doubt shall arise as to the meaning or intent of anything in the Invitation to Bid, inquiry should be made to the Administrator, Ken Hamilton at (410) 287-6173 or khamilton@charlestownmd.org before the bid is submitted.
