**Low Speed Vehicle Purchase** – There was discussion regarding the recent purchase of the UTV from Lowe's and whether it should be returned, since Wednesday, July 6<sup>th</sup> marks the end of their seven-day return policy. There was general consensus that everyone should be happy with the vehicle, including how it represented the Town and Town staff. The Park Rangers would be the most common users of the vehicle on the weekends; however, all Town staff can use it for work purposes. Commissioner Wood made a motion to return the UTV to Lowe's, which was seconded by Commissioner Elmer. Approved 4-1, with Commissioner Capano opposed, since the UTV only cost \$8,500.

Another low-speed vehicle was presented for consideration by Commissioner Elmer, a golf cart with a dump body for \$13,512.25. Commissioner Wood made a motion to purchase the golf cart, which was seconded by Commissioner Elmer. Approved 5-0.

Commissioner Wood motioned to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Fields seconded. Approved 5-0.
